Richard W. Wiseman '73 has been elected chair of the Addison & Randolph Clark Society.



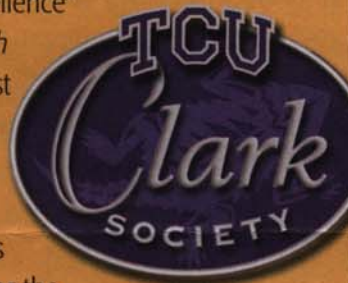
